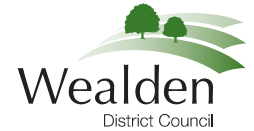


Application for Riding Establishment Licence

Riding Establishments Acts 1964 And 1970



INFORMATION NOTES

1. A licence may be granted to an individual over the age of eighteen years or a body corporate.
2. A copy of the Standard Conditions to be attached to the licence is enclosed. There may also be special conditions attached to the licence which will be settled on consideration of the application.
3. (i) 'Horse' includes any mare, gelding, pony, foal, colt, filly or stallion, and also any ass, mule or jennet.
(ii) The Act regulates riding establishments which let out horses on hire or use them for the purpose of providing, in return for payment, instruction in riding or for the purpose of demonstrating riding.
4. All licences are issued on 1st January each year and are valid for one year. Licences can be issued mid-year but carry the same fee.
